## Preparing the simulator for use:

- 1. Place muscle and bone inside skin until it fits snugly.
- 2. Fasten Velcro® strap to keep bone and muscle in place.

#### **Instructions for use:**

- 1. Use the smallest gauge needle possible to demonstrate injection technique. We suggest a 21 gauge or smaller.
- 2. Water or other innocuous material may be used in the syringe if desired. Do not use saline solution; it can deteriorate the material of the hip.
- 3. After use, squeeze our water, but do not twist.
- 4. Leave in a well ventilated area to dry.

#### **Care and Maintenance:**

- I. Clean with mild soap and water; do not submerse trainer or parts in cleaning fluids or water.
- 2. Use only on clean surface. Avoid felt tipped markers, ink pens, acetone, iodine or other staining products and avoid placing the trainer on newsprint or inked lines of any kind.
- 3. To ensure longevity, the trainer should be cleaned after each training session and a general inspection should be conducted regularly.
- 4. Modules and all other parts should be drained and airdried thoroughly before storage and disinfected when needed
- 5. Articulating parts will benefit from a light application of talcum powder prior to training sessions.
- 6. Store properly between teaching sessions.
